Foyer de Chevrens

This building aims to welcome and meet the educational needs of 14 to 18 year old adolescents placed in boarding schools. The new buildings of the Centre de Chevrens revere the guidelines of the existing fabric by reinforcing in particular the single-front structure of the village-street with an irregular succession of courses and narrowings. Around the courtyard, two distinct volumes share the main functions and can be identified by their uses. A double building serves as living space and the second volume is devoted to training. The façades' design draws inspiration from the surroundings. It combines the masonry façades of the local houses and the wooden cladding of the surrounding farms by using traditional wooden façades as formwork bases for reinforced concrete façades, creating a natural appearance.
